

Gospel Meditation

All of us, perhaps at some point in our lives, have had the experience of playing the role of good sons-daughters in family life. But, we have also played the role of not being as good as expected. So, this parable of the prodigal son fits us like a glove. What feelings or memories come to your mind when you listen to it? Do you feel that the Father is unfair to his eldest son? Do you think she has spoiled her youngest child too much? Whatever our response, it should lead us to a deep reflection of God's unconditional love for his two children. However, let us not lose the point of view that Jesus tells this parable to tax collectors and sinners, and how the Pharisees and scribes criticized Jesus because he ate with them.

"With the parable of the prodigal son, Jesus tells us that God always waits for us, just like the father, who waits for the return of his son. He leaves us free, lets us make mistakes and learn, and in this way return, just like the prodigal son did" (Pope Francis). Pope Francis gives us the key that we must carry out, learning to return every time we move away.

Not giving up, moving forward and asking for forgiveness is brave.

Learn from the mistakes made and return to a new beginning, but well accompanied by the grace of God.

Feel strength when hearing: "You are always with me and all that is mine is yours" (Luke 15:31).

Scripture Reflections

First Reading

As Israel settled into the land of Canaan (the Promised Land), they learned God removed the "reproach" of Egypt from them and they could freely eat from the land. What have you discovered about yourself or others during this season of Lent?

Second Reading

Paul taught that reconciliation with God and with each other was key to being a "new creation."

How often do you experience reconciliation with God or with others?

Gospel

In the parable of the Prodigal Son, in a real sense, both sons are lost.

How might you help a lost family member or friend this week?





This charity program that connects traditional Lenten almsgiving with the nutritional needs of poor families and homeless in the Folsom area has been a huge success for the men of Council 6197. The program is simple- collect canned/package food items each day during the 40 days of Lent.

What food should I donate: Healthy, non-perishable food. Items with intact, unopened, consumer or commercial packaging, non-breakable packaging (no glass please). Food within the expiration date on the packaging

What are the most requested food items?

- Canned meats like tuna, chicken, turkey, ham, stew and chili, canned vegetables
- Pasta & pasta sauce, beans, rice
- Healthy cereals, peanut butter, baby food & baby formula

Drop off the food items into our Knights of Columbus Cart located outside in front of the church designated with signs "40 Cans for Lent" before and after every Mass on Saturday and Sunday. Items can also be dropped off at the St. Vincent de Paul location next to SJND school building and parking lot on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:00 am to 12 Noon.
