Gospel Meditation

By Father John Muir

A young couple in my parish told me they were expecting their second child, a baby boy. I knew that their five-year old only child Emma had been desperately wanting to be a big sister for years, so I said, "Emma must have been so happy when you told her the news." "Actually," they said, "she burst into tears. She wanted a baby sister!" How often in life God wonderfully fulfills our desires and we are sad because we don't approve of the way he does it. We want to control the gift and the delivery method.

The same thing occurs in the Gospel this week when Jesus announces in his hometown that the promise of an Anointed One bringing glad tidings to the poor is "fulfilled in your hearing" (Luke 4:21). After a moment of elation, his fellow townsfolk realize this man is the way God is fulfilling his promises, and they erupt into a violent outburst. So Jesus departs. How sad for them.

Every single Sunday at Mass, including this one, some version of this happens to many of us. God's word announces the fulfillment of God's promises in Christ, and we easily overlook or disdain it. His way is almost never according to our narrow expectations. What's required of us is to set these aside, and to embrace a new openness to God's gifts, no matter how he wishes to give them. God is fulfilling his promises the way He likes — why be sad?

Paul uses the human body as an analogy for the many and varied parts of the Christian community. What role would you like to have in your parish?

We hear how Jesus began to reveal his true identity as Israel's long-awaited Messiah in his hometown of Nazareth. Have you ever received news that you thought was unbelievable? What was it?



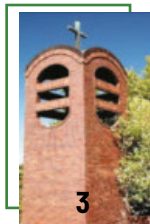

The Saint John the Baptist Men's Ministry recently made Blessing Bags, which are care packages for you to give to the homeless you might encounter in your daily lives. Each bag contains a pair of socks, lotion, tissues, lip balm, a bottle of water, and a few snacks. Keep one in your car, and when you encounter a homeless person on the street or stopped at a red light, you have something readily available to give to them. Also in each bag is a blank greeting card for you to write a work of encouragement. These bags are in a bin in the narthex, please take one home today.

Knights of Columbus Council 6197

Neighbors Helping Neighbors

Our Bishop Gallegos Council 6197, along with our St. Vincent de Paul ministry collected to date a total of 197 coats for kids; 65 coats for teens and 451 coats for adults, along with sleeping bags, gloves, blankets, socks and winter hats. They have handed out 326 adults, 30 teens and 98+ child coats, so far. Our goal for Columbian Year 2024-2025 was 400+ coats along with blankets, socks, sleeping bags, tents, shoes, warm caps and gloves. We collected a total of 713 coats and exceeded our goal by 313 coats! To date we also collected food items weighing in at 1,379 total pounds. Our goal by January 12, 2025 was to collect at least 1,000 pounds. We exceeded our goal by 379 pounds. God is Good All the Time! The St. Vincent de Paul ministry plans to distribute the Coats for Kids and Food for Families items throughout the winter and holiday seasons for any and all needy and homeless here in Folsom including the surrounding cities and neighborhoods in need.
